How to reach us by public transportation

From Termini Station

- Bus H: 6 stops to Piazza Sonnino
- Bus 64: 6 stops to Piazza Venezia and, from here, take tram 8 for 3 stops to Piazza Belli
- Bus 40: 3 stops to Piazza Venezia and, from here, take tram 8 for 3 stops to Piazza Belli

From Trastevere Station

- Tram 8 (direction Piazza Venezia): 5 stops to Piazza Belli

From the Ostiense-Piramide Station

- Tram 3 (direction Trastevere Station): 5 stops to "Porta Portese" or 6 stops to "Ministry of Public Education"
- Bus 75 (Poerio-Marino direction): 6 stops to "Nuovo Regina Margherita"

About us

The National Institute for Health, Migration and Poverty (INMP) is a public institution under the authority of the Ministry of Health. It is part of the National Health Services and was established in 2007 to address the social and health challenges posed by the most vulnerable populations: migrants and people living in poverty. The INMP takes charge of anyone that seeks assistance, Italians and migrants alike, that face serious social and economic hardships and may also face inequalities in the access to health services.

The Institute is *Reference Centre for the National Network for social and health care issues related to migrant populations and poverty* and the *National Centre for transcultural mediation for the social and health care sector*. It is also *WHO Collaborating Centre for migrant's health evidence and capacity building*.

The mission

The INMP mission is to develop and implement innovative systems to counteract health inequalities, facilitate the access to the National

Health Service to the most disadvantaged social groups, ensuring them social and health care of high quality.

The main activities

The INMP pursues its mission and objectives by providing: immediate access to health and social care at its outpatient facility in Rome, which is equipped with advanced medical instrumentation and equipment; activities of proximity medicine in outreach; medical and psychological care at the hotspots of Lampedusa and Trapani-Milo; clinical and public health research; training of social and healthcare professionals (INMP is a CME provider).

More specifically, the INMP:

- Through a multidisciplinary staff of medical doctors, psychologists, nurses, transcultural mediators and anthropologists, the Institute provides multi-professional and, in the case of migrants, also transcultural care, taking charge of patients in a holistic manner during the entire process: from their reception through care and assistance.

- Organizes training courses, with CME credits and not, as well as health education activities and communication. In particular, it provides courses on transcultural mediation in health and social care.
- Carries out quali-quantitative research including: clinical and translational research; studies of experimental models for the management of health services, specifically focused on poverty-related diseases and on social exclusion; anthropological and public health studies.
- Collects, analyses and disseminates national epidemiological and statistical data regarding the health of vulnerable populations, with the involvement of the regional reference centers.
- Implements projects with national and European funding.

From 1 January 2008 to 30 June 2020, the INMP assisted **124,356 patients**, 41,3% of whom were Italians in 2019, with **521,460 accesses**. From April 2016 to September 2017, the Institute also assisted **6,370 patients** with **11,471 accesses** at the Lampedusa and Trapani-Milo hotspots.
