Who we are

INMP - public body of the Italian National Health Service under the supervision of the Ministry of Health - was established in 2007 for facing social and health challenges posed by vulnerable populations. The Institute takes care of Italian and migrant people experiencing severe economic and social disadvantage and facing major obstacle to access health care.

- *WHO Collaborating Centre on Health and Migration Evidence and Capacity Building*

The mission

To develop and implement innovative systems for combating health inequalities in the National

Health Service, by facilitating access to public healthcare for disadvantaged social groups and guaranteeing high-quality services.

The main activities

INMP pursues its mission and objectives by providing health assistance using high-quality medical equipment in its Outpatient clinic as well as outreaching services and global health interventions in Italy and abroad. It is also committed to clinical and epidemiological research and training for health professionals (it is CME provider).

In particular, INMP:

- Puts into practice a holistic model for reception, health assistance and treatment with a multidisciplinary staff composed of medical doctors, psychologists, nurses, transcultural mediators and anthropologists.
- Realises CME and non-CME training, education and health communication programmes. It also develops courses for transcultural mediation in the health field.

- Carries out qualitative and quantitative research through clinical projects, the study of experimental models for managing health services aimed at poverty and social exclusion-related diseases, anthropological and public health research.
- Carries out the activities of the National Epidemiological Observatory on the health condition of vulnerable people.
- Implements projects supported by Italian and European funds.

From 1 January 2008 to 28 February 2022 **590.202 examinations** have been provided at INMP Outpatient Clinic for **133.942 people** (average **4.4 accesses** per patient), including Italians of different social groups and migrants.
